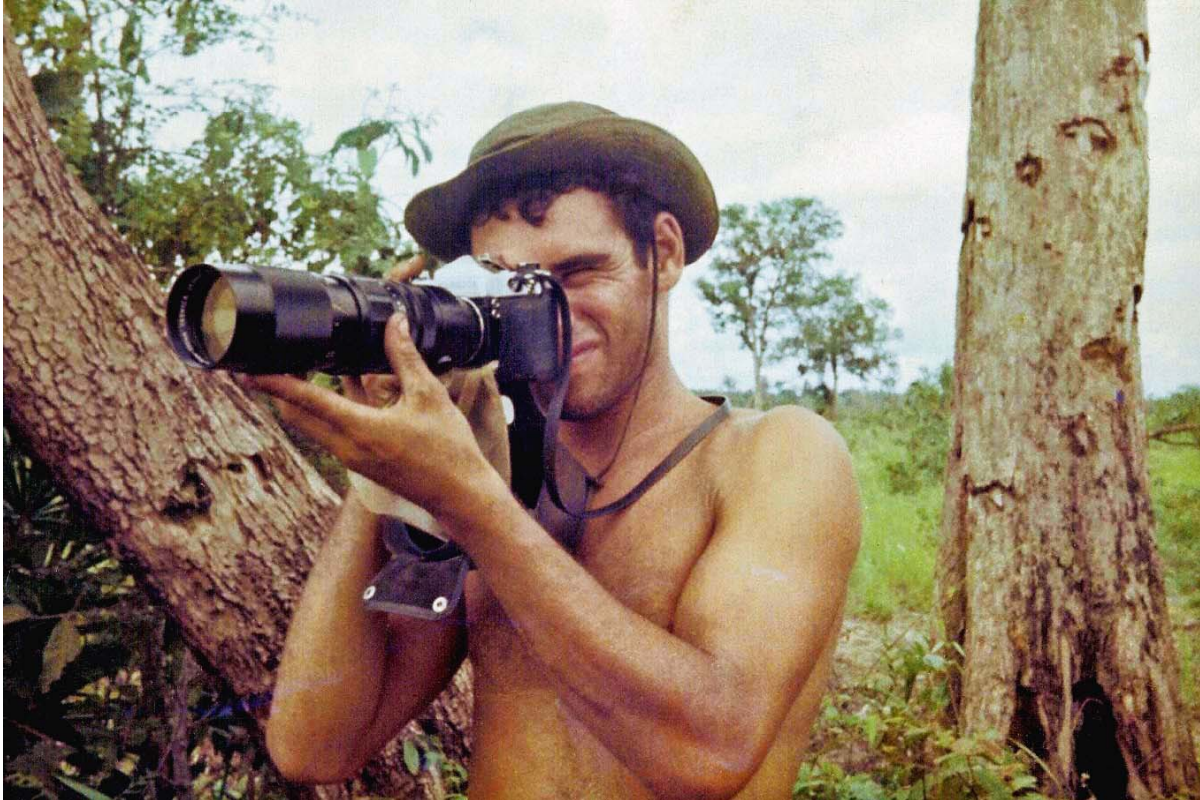

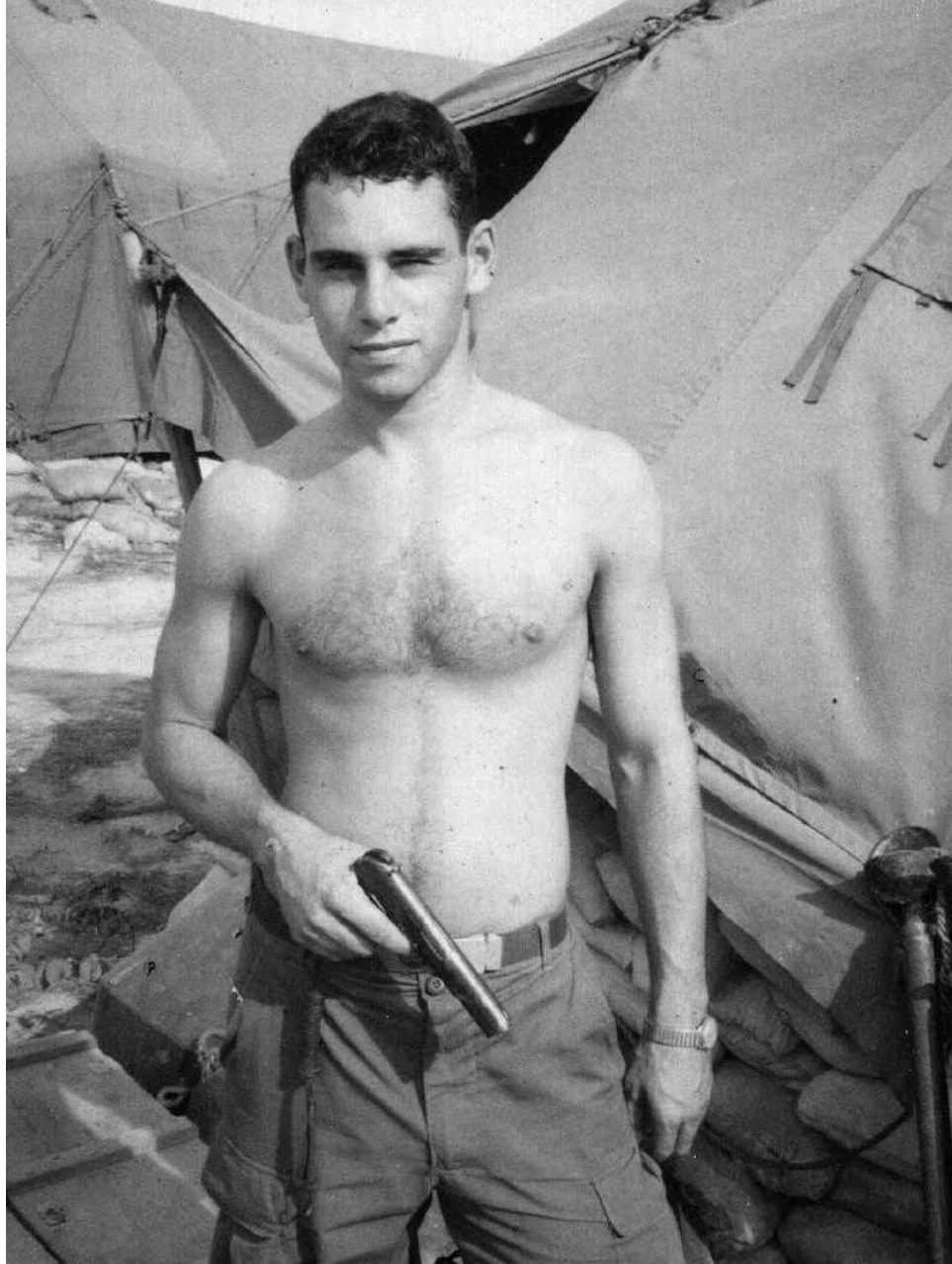

Bill Noyes

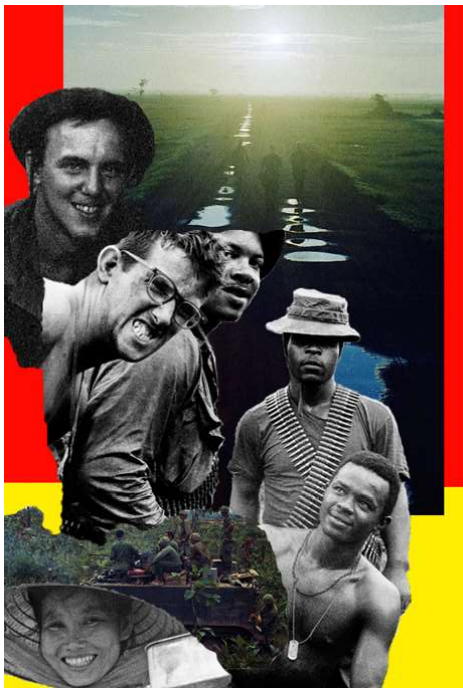

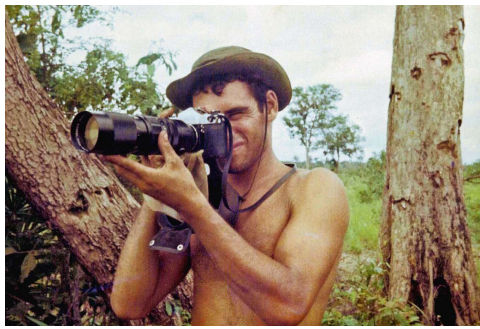


Bill Noyes with wife Judy, (2015)

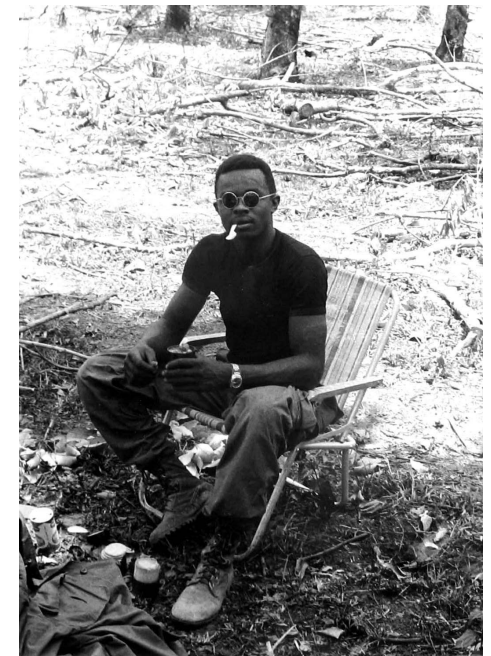

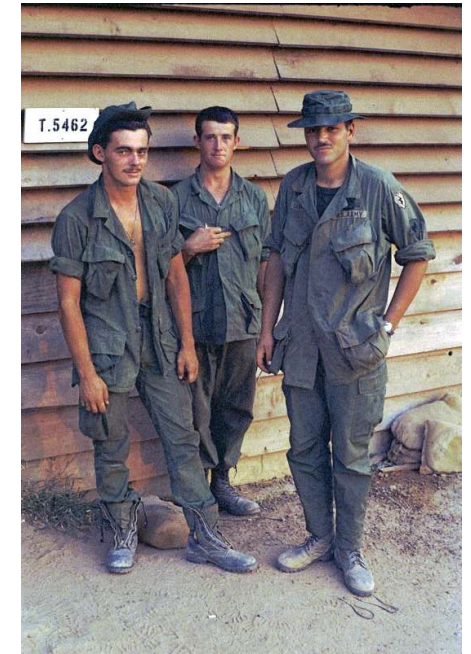

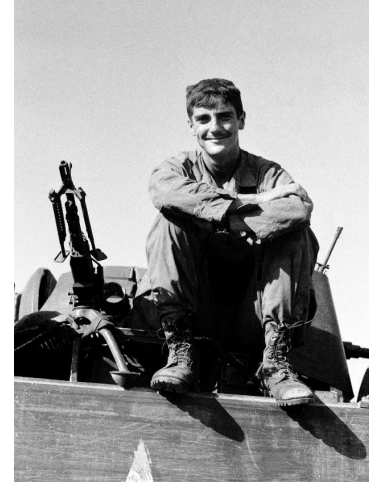

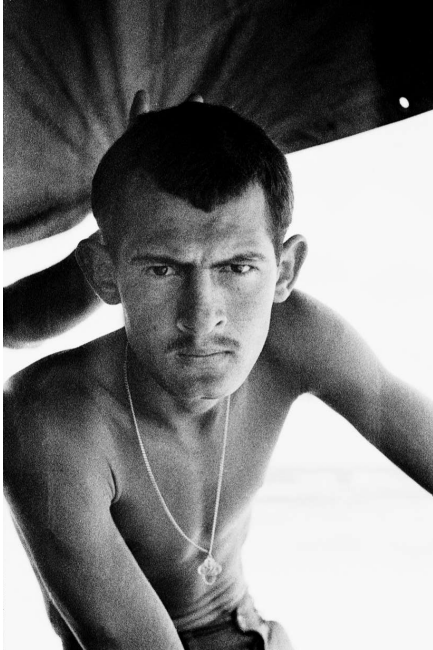

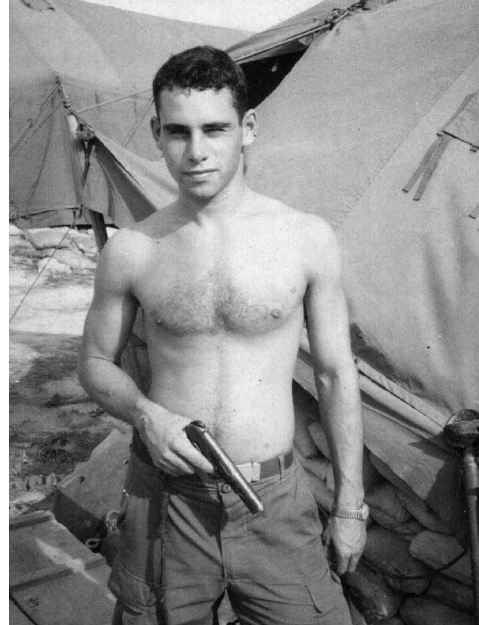

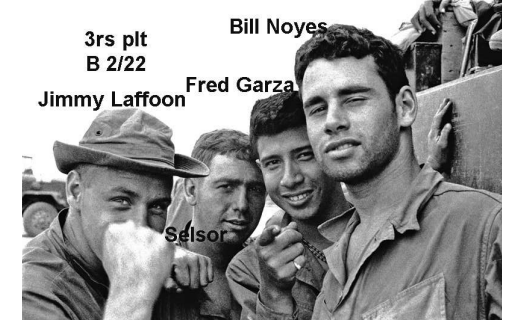

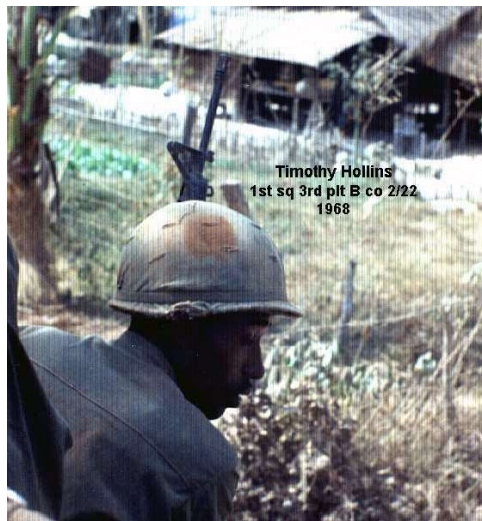

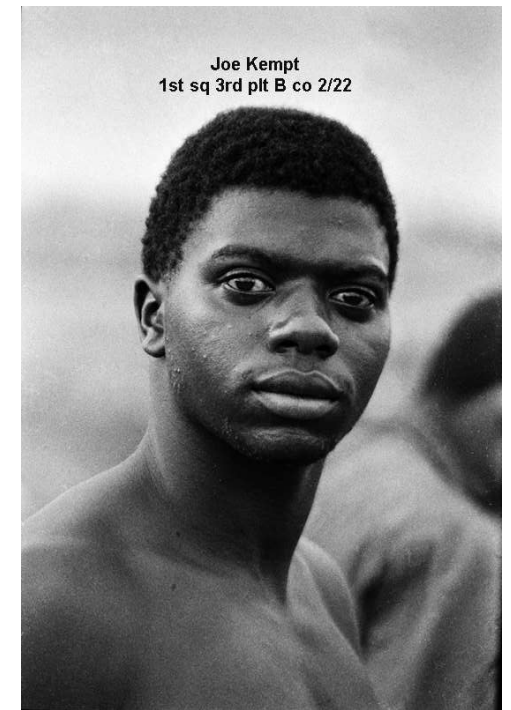

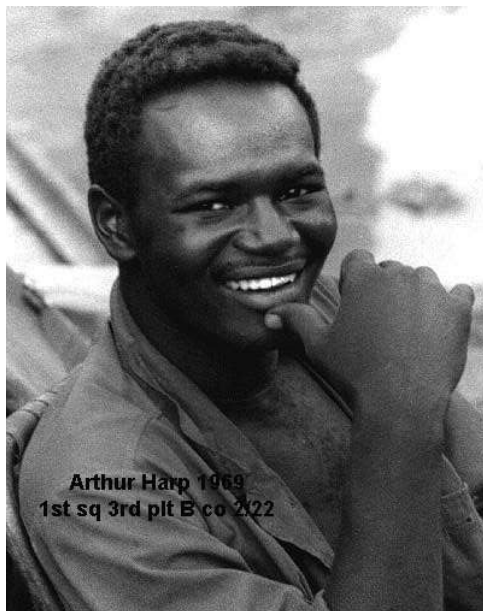

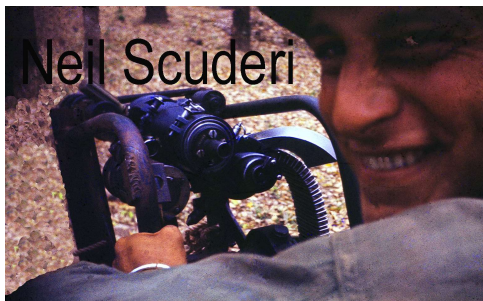
